



- 2 Choose a time period (Note! The default setting is for the previous month) and a group of predefined sources (continent, language, etc.) Search using your own preselected criteria
- 3 Hit the Search button

...or an advanced search (multiple criteria)




Indicate the time period. You can either use the predefined periods or indicate a period from the list or by using the calendars

6 Click on the Recommencer (Start again) button to empty the search page of all the criteria you'd given (key words, sources...)




